Dear Student/Parent,

At the very outset I congratulate you for choosing Galgotias College of Engineering and Technology. As you know, we have a proven track record of academic excellence of almost two decades and near 100% placements.

Achieving a cent percent placement was not easy but for our endeavor to constantly engage with the user industry to ascertain/gauge their ever changing requirements.

On the basis of the industry feedback a School of Lifelong Learning (SLLL) was set up at Galgotias with the aim of preparing the future engineers for facing the rigors of the placement process and the corporate life thereafter. The School conducts English Proficiency Program and Quantitative Aptitude sessions for students from the first semester itself to align their employability skills with those mandated by the industry.
